Uniforms

- Students will be expected to wear our formal uniforms to our Spring and Winter Concerts and our Choir T-shirts to informal concerts. These can be worn throughout their time in choir.
- All students can purchase a Cantando Choir T-shirt for \$12.
- Girls In Cantando, the girls wear a floor-length black dress with a sash. This dress is about \$70. It will need to be hemmed after ordering it to fit your child. (This can be let out if your student grows during their years in Cantando.)
- Boys In Cantando, the boys wear a black shirt, black pants, and a black tie. Their outfit usually costs about \$50.
- All of our T-shirts and Concert uniforms can be purchased by filling out our uniform order form and returning it to Kim Latta with cash or a check payable to SSCHE.
- If you need help purchasing a choir uniform, you can buy used uniforms at a discounted price. Please let me know if you are interested in this option!

Expectations

- Rehearsal Attendance: Please be at all rehearsals unless absence is pre-approved.
- **Performances**: Choir members are expected to participate in all performances. Please plan to arrive at least 15 minutes early for all concerts.
- Behavior: It is expected that students in Cantando behave well at all times—on stage, in rehearsal or during out of Choir trips. We represent SCCHE and strive to set a Christ-like example in all that we do. If a student has difficulty meeting this expectation she/he may be dismissed from choir for the remainder of the year.
- Commitment: As with any extra-curricular activity, choir members are expected to commit for the duration of the season- in this case the remainder of the year. Please understand that, by the nature of this group, a student who leaves choir due to behavioral or academic concerns will not have an opportunity to return until the next year (or possibly at the semester break). As with math, we learn new skills every day and to expect a student to know and demonstrate skills learned in his/her absence would be unfair.

I am looking forward to an amazing year for our Cantando choir and I am so glad that you have chosen to be a part of it! \odot
